D.J.S (Disciples of Jesus) Room 109

A mix of 40-60 year olds participate in a scripture-based study with group discussion covering current events and personal experiences. The class is led by Dr. Joel Hutchins.

God's Mix Room 105

As the name suggests, this class is a mix of men and women ages 40 through 80 years of age. Members pursue the word of God through the use of varied Bible-based studies and open discussion.

King's Daughters Room 107

This group of senior, adult women led by Lorene Kehler and Ellen Schirmer have chosen the "Adult Bible Studies" quarterly to assist them in their study of God's word. They enjoy singing together prior to the lesson.

Seekers Room 103

This class of adults, ages 50+, choose thought-provoking books for study and discussion. One of their favorite authors is James W. Moore. They also meet several times a year for fellowship and developing relationships.

Taking It To The Streets Room 102
